- No outside food or beverage may be brought in except for cake or other desserts from grocery/bakery
- The guest fee for parties is \$11 per non-member, ages 3 and up
- All guests must sign a guest waiver
- No party leader is provided, TCR staff will set up food & beverage area and deliver food & drinks at the time specified by the Party Host.

Pool Party Rules & Expectations:

Supervision

1. TCR will provide lifeguard coverage at all times the pool is in operation.
2. Kiddie Pool – Parents, sitters or nannies must accompany and watch their children at all times while they are in the Kiddie Pool area.
3. Children age 5 and under must be accompanied into the big pool, kid’s bathrooms, pool changing area and outdoor shower by a parent, sitter or nanny. Children that require flotation devices such as life vests, swimmies or other devices are not permitted in the deep end without a person 16 or older in the water with them.
4. Children ages 6 & 7 must be under parent, sitter or nanny supervision in the pool area, kid’s bathrooms, and pool changing area.
5. Deep End Test – Children age 8 and over who pass a “one length of the pool” and “tread water” swim test under lifeguard supervision may use the pool unattended.
6. All children age 12 and under must be accompanied and supervised at all times by a guardian who is at least 16 years old.

Pool Safety

1. No throwing of hard objects (tennis balls, torpedoes)
2. No Running or Diving.
3. Stay off of Lifeguard chairs.
4. No Chairs or tables within 8 feet of the pool.
5. No swimming or use of pool area without a lifeguard present.
6. Lifeguards are responsible for safety and supervision of the pool. Please follow their directives.
7. Certain flotation devices and toys may be used with the permission of the Lifeguard.

Hygiene

1. Pollution of the pool water is prohibited. Parents are responsible to supervise their children and insist on bathroom breaks. This is a serious matter that affects everyone. The quality of the pool water is strictly regulated, and any compromise jeopardizes health and safety. The pool may be forced to close depending on the nature of the incident. Remember, accidents are as likely to be caused by youngsters as toddlers.
2. Swimming type diapers are required for any child age 3 and under and those not potty-trained.
3. Diaper changing is to be done in the children’s bathrooms or pool changing facility.
4. Any person with infections, communicative diseases, open cuts, or blisters is prohibited from using the pool.

General

1. Bathing suits are required for swimming – No shorts.
2. No animals or bicycles in the pool area.
3. No rough play or excessive noise in the pool area, kid’s bathrooms, pool changing area or outdoor shower.
4. Lap lanes are reserved for adult lap swimmers age 18 and over. Please keep children and toys out. If lap lane is not in use, children can use the lane for laps if approved by pool director or lifeguard.

Food & Beverage

1. Food and beverages are allowed in the pool area. TCR has a snack bar, which is generally open when pool is in operation. Please help keep the pool area clean. No outside food or beverages are allowed on club property unless authorized by a club manager
2. No glass is allowed in pool area.
3. Alcoholic beverages must be purchased through TCR.

Grass Area & Playground

1. No ball playing, frisbee, or horseplay.
2. Please - no children in designated adult only canopies and/or areas.
3. Parents and guardians are to ensure that children do not throw gravel from the playground. Keep gravel out of the pools.
